1. Identifies one example of how sociology can be used outside of the classroom (applied, clinical, or public)
2. ***Applies this approach to their own career, field, or area of study by explaining:
 - o What they would do
 - o Where it would happen
 - o Who it would impact
 - o What session(s) most relate or connect to this issue.
